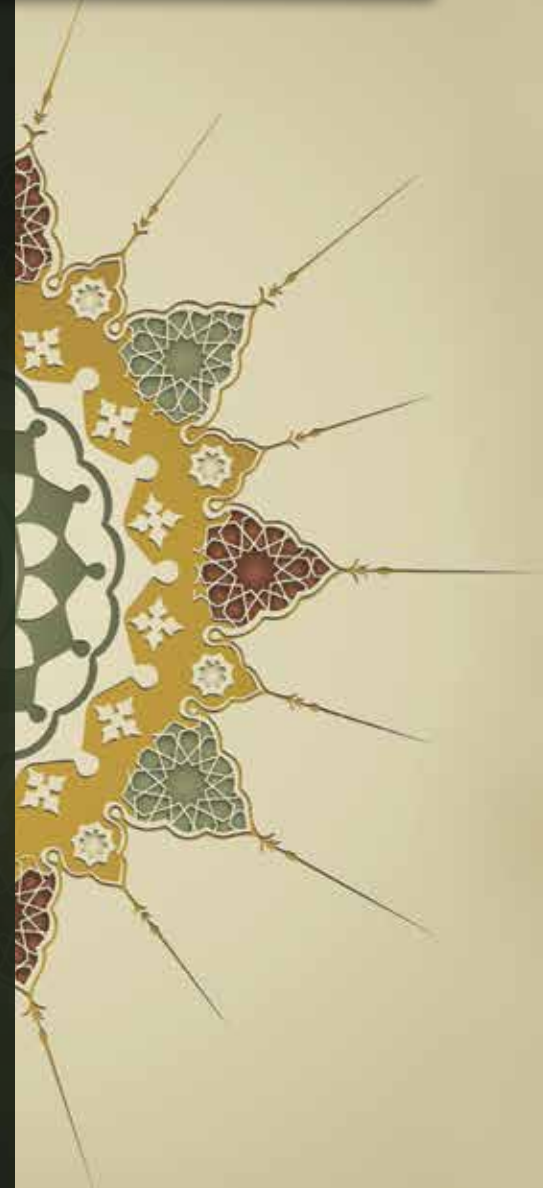

ISF was established in 1989 with the vision to create a full-time school that delivers exceptional academic instruction within an Islamic setting, fostering both individual achievement and community progress.

Brighter Horizons Academy [**BHA**] has flourished into one of the largest comprehensive Islamic schools in the Southern United States. The academy aims to deliver high quality education rooted in Islamic values, and to produce students who are proud Muslim Americans with a strong ethical foundation.

BHA graduates continue to attend top universities across the country, with many advancing to successful careers as professionals who give back to both the community and society at large.

BHA was founded in 1989 by Islamic Services Foundation. The first building was a 2,000 sq ft residential property purchased in 1990, located on Polk Street, Richardson, Texas. The current campus property was purchased in 1993, and an adjacent office building was acquired in 2003. Today, **BHA** campus consists of several buildings for Middle and High School, Elementary School and Preschool totaling nearly 135,000 sq ft.

A Vision for the Future of BHA

The vision and strategy for **BHA** calls for:

- Best Tarbiyah, Arabic, Qur'an and Islamic Studies [TAQI] program in the nation in the next 3 years
- A center of excellence among the top 10% of private schools in the DFW area in the next 10 years
- Financial stability, while keeping the school accessible to the community
- Expanded facilities and campuses across DFW so more students have access to **BHA** education
- Lead in sports among private schools in DFW [in TAPPS]

With the goal of reaching \$20-30 million in the next 5 to 10 years, the **ISF Endowment** will secure the financial future of Islamic education and enable **BHA** to become a top-tier institution, competing with the best private schools in the nation, and expand its footprint across DFW and beyond in order to reach more students. It is an investment in the future of our children and grandchildren, to better prepare them for the challenges of the modern world and the responsibilities of their faith.

What is ISF Endowment "Waqf"?

An endowment fund is a financial asset, in the form of a donation that is invested to generate income. The principal amount remains intact, while the earnings from the investment are used to fund organizational initiatives and objectives.

ISF Endowment [Waqf] is dedicated to creating financial stability and providing necessary funds to make **BHA** a center of leadership and educational excellence, build more **BHA** campuses across the DFW metroplex, and provide financial aid and scholarships to deserving Muslim students, for many generations to come.

By prioritizing education, Islamic knowledge, character building, and leadership, it empowers future Muslim generations to thrive in the United States. The community will benefit from high quality education that is affordable and is accessible at multiple campuses in DFW, and from financial aid and scholarships to more deserving Muslim students.

What is the goal of this endowment fund?

Our goal for the coming year is to raise \$3 million. Insha'Allah, this will help set us up on a strong path to grow the **ISF Endowment** to \$20 to \$30 million in the next 5 to 10 years and build a strong financial foundation to support the long-term vision of high-quality education for many generations of Muslim students in the United States.



ISF ENDOWMENT **FAQ?**

Who manages the endowment fund?

The endowment fund is overseen by an elected board of directors and paid professional financial team. They will ensure responsible investments, within Islamic guidelines.

How is the money invested?

All investments will strictly adhere to Islamic principles.

Can I specify how my donation is used?

It is not possible to track individual donations. The endowment ensures that all contributions are allocated effectively to support the mission and objectives of the Waqf.

Is my donation tax-deductible?

Yes. The **ISF Endowment** is a 501[c][3] nonprofit organization, and every donation will receive a IRS receipt.

How can I contribute to the endowment fund?

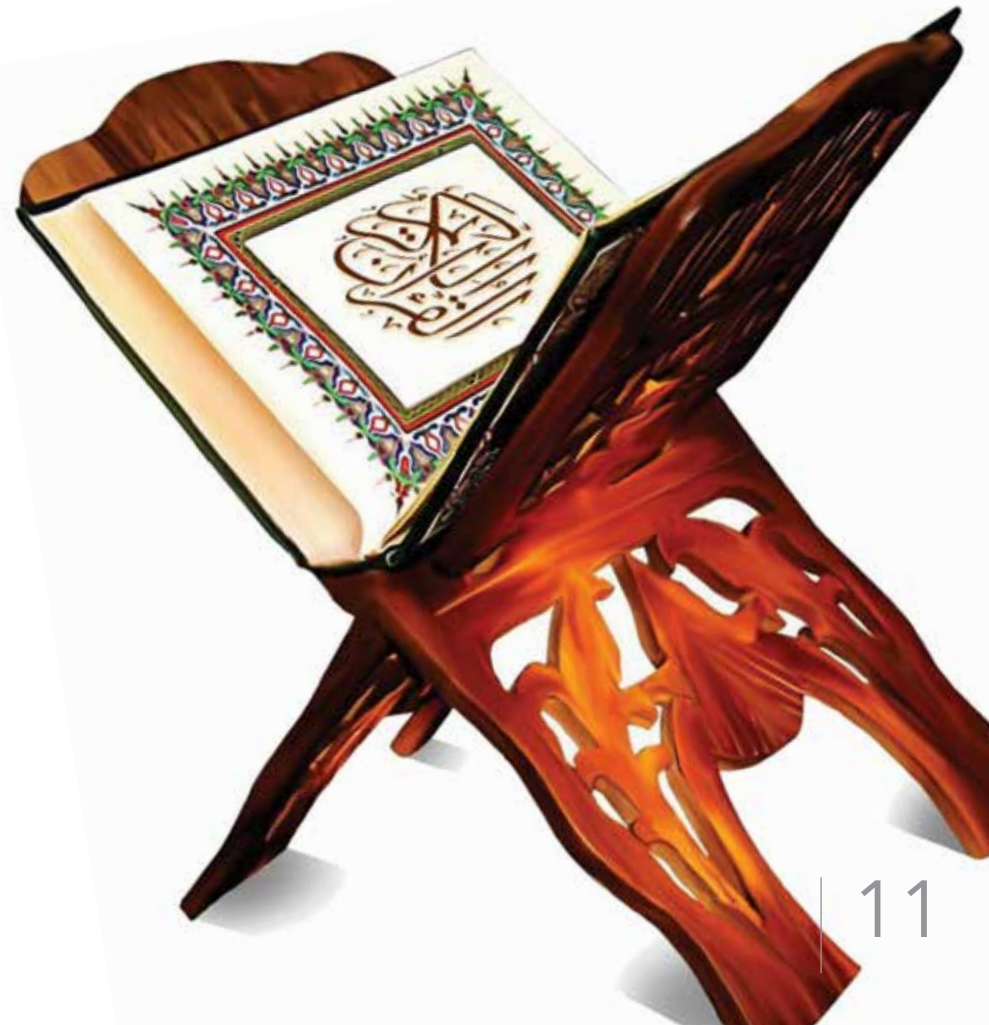
You can contribute through a one-time donation, pledges, and recurring contributions. You may even include the endowment in your will or estate planning.
